Cancellation Policy for Canine Good Manners Class:

I understand that my registration fee covers the 6-week session of Canine Good Manners Class, and that I am purchasing a spot reserved for my dog and myself (or handler). The fee is nonrefundable regardless of how many of the six classes I attend. Classes missed will not be refunded. Make up classes will not be offered.

If my dog goes into season during the six-week session, I will leave the dog home during her heat, but attend class without her. In the event that my dog is ill, injured or possibly carrying a communicable disease, I agree to not bring my dog to class. I am welcome to attend class without my dog.

I confirm that my dog has no known history of aggression. This includes growling, showing teeth or lunging at people or dogs. If I am asked to leave due to excessive disruption caused by myself or my dog, I will not receive a refund (barking is not considered grounds for dismissal).

The first class of the session is mandatory. If I miss the first class, in which clicker training is explained and demonstrated, I will not be allowed to continue and will forfeit my registration fee.

In the event that class is cancelled due to hazardous driving conditions, students will be notified by email by 4:00 pm on the day of the class. Students are responsible for checking email or calling one of the instructors to determine if class is cancelled.

Exceptions to this policy are as follows:

If I have attended previous CAKC clicker classes, the first night of class may be missed without consequences.

If I drop out more than one week prior to the beginning of the first class, I am entitled to a refund.

If the session is cancelled by the CAKC, I am entitled to a refund or a credit toward the next six-week session.
